Makeover Update

As 2011 came to a close we saw Sanyati Baptist Hospital in a much better position than it was twelve months ago. Seventy-three people from seven states traveled to Sanyati to help with the Makeover. Three churches in Zimbabwe sent teams to help and both Sanyati locals and hospital staff were on hand to assist with the project. Altogether over one hundred volunteers worked on fixing up the hospital. Electrical cable for the solar power system has been run, one building is under roof, and insulation has been added to the pharmacy storage area.

I returned from Zimbabwe in late December, where I purchased additional supplies, material, and equipment for the 2012 teams. Sixteen teams are already committed for 2012 and

there are several more who are planning to go but have not yet committed to a date. If you want to send a team in 2012 please contact me soon; there are still a few openings left.

The majority of these teams have agreed to work on replacing the roofs. It is our hope by the end of 2012 that we will see over 80% of the roofs replaced, then work can get underway on the inside in 2013.

We are thrilled to have Chick-fil-A working with us on this project! Also, Ryan Sifford (and family) from Texas will serve as the On-Site Job Coordinator for six months in 2012.
